## PotashCorp wins top CICA award for third straight year

Potash Corporation of Saskatchewan Inc. has been given the top award for corporate reporting for the third straight year.

The award is adjudicated by the Canadian Institute of Chartered Accountants (CICA). PotashCorp is the first company to win the overall award for excellence for the third straight year.

The company also won the top award within the mining sector and for its electronic disclosures.

It received honourable mentions in the sub-categories of corporate governance disclosure, financial reporting and sustainable development reporting.
